About the Faculty of Agriculture

Founded in 1942 and considered the third oldest in the country. The main language of instruction is Arabic; however, in 1962 international students joined the faculty with English as their instruction language. Since then, a bachelor's degree has been offered in English for international students. In 1996 Egyptians were also permitted to join the English instructed program creating a melting pot. For the past decade an average of 70 international students have been registered in the faculty annually. In 2004 a French teaching program was launched in collaboration with the French government in the field of Dairy Science and Technology where international students mainly from French speaking countries perused their studies along with their French speaking Egyptian fellow students.

Why Choose Alexandria University

THE CITY of Alexandria, is an ancient city where civilizations have mingled for ages, and today it resembles the mix of history and modernity. It was a harbor, with a famous light house, exporting 1/3 the Egyptian wheat needed by the Roman Empire and later exporting Egyptian cotton to the British Empire. Undergraduate Studies

A typical academic program will consist of two semesters (Spring & Fall) 15 weeks each. A summer intensive session (8 weeks) could also be initiated. At least 140 credit hours must be fulfilled successfully before graduation (a credit hour is equivalent to a one-hour classroom or two hours of out-of-class, weekly). All programs include a number of elective courses planned and coordinated to provide scientific and technological knowledge, activate self motivation, and raise the ability for creative thinking and innovative approaches in problem solving.

Facilities

The Faculty of Agriculture has two experimental stations. one 90 km away represents newly reclaimed land. The second is only 20 minutes far from campus and has a fully equipped poultry, animal production, milk production and fish production facilities. Nearly 100 ha of of excellent quality land for training, extension and research in all aspects of agriculture. Also, a wide range of modern laboratories, among which, a central lab for sample analysis, tissue culture facility, small-scaled factories including an entire dairy factory, cotton ginning facility and food canning and processing facility that give students hands-on experience for future careers and serve as research facilities for postgraduate students. Students have easy access to computer labs used for teaching and research. Students have access to a wide range of scientific journals and e-books through receiving an account from the Egyptian Universities Libraries Consortium. Standard libraries are available at every department in addition to a central library serving all students of the faculty.

International Student Office

In the nineties and because of the increasing number of international students enrolled, a student office was established to facilitate the enrollment and graduation procedures of students, to organize the class and exam schedules, give advice and address any issues related to international students. An orientation day is usually organized by the office for freshly enrolled students. It also assists enrolment in university dorms. The office represents the link between students and both the staff members and the faculty's administration.
