Admissions



- Applicants for this programme should meet existing Egyptian National Entry requirements to study Dentistry at the University of Alexandria.
- 2 Potential candidates for the programme will be interviewed using the University of Manchester's existing methods and interviews will take place at Alexandria Faculty of Dentistry, successful students will be selected jointly by both universities.
- The online application and admission process for the programme will be detailed on Alexandria Faculty of Dentistry UoM/UoA BDS Joint Degree website.
- 4 The English Language requirements are mandatory for students in this programme and set out as follows:
 - National high school students (Thanwaya Amma): minimum score of 6.5 overall with 6.5 of IELTS in each component.
 - · IGCSE students: O-Level English at Grade B or above.
 - American Diploma students will be considered in combination with SAT/ACT results or if the candidate also sits the BMAT. A minimum GPA of 3.5 (English and math offered in Year 12 is a must)

Academic rules



- The programme follows the credit hours system, A student is required to finish 181 credit hours on average in ten semesters / five years in order to graduate.
- The academic year has two main semesters; fall and spring, each consisting of 15 weeks.
- 3 A student can register an average of 16-18 credits per semester.

Graduation



The official graduation ceremony will be held at Alexandria University with representatives from the University of Manchester present. Students who complete the programme will also be entitled to attend a graduation ceremony at the University of Manchester and this will be at their own expense.
