Alexandria – Essex Dual Master's Degree in Periodontology



The program is a collaboration between **Alexandria University** (AU), Egypt and the **University of Essex**, UK. The program duration is 3 years. The first 2 years will be in Alexandria University, Egypt, and the final year will be in the University of Essex, UK. Admission will be open to graduates from all universities according to Alexandria Postgraduate International Program regulations. Applicants should have a minimum grade of **Very Good** in their undergraduate program.

At the end of this program each candidate will receive two separate certificates of achievements, Master's Degree of Periodontology from AU and MSc Periodontology Science and Practice from Essex. Registration will start in July and the first semester will start in September.

Students should successfully pass a minimum of 22 courses of 46 credit hours at AU in 2 years.

AU Program Clinical Requirements



1st Semester

4 Cases of gingivectomy divided as follows;

- 2 Cases surgical gingivectomy
- 1 Case laser gingivectomy
- 1 Case esthetic crown lengthening

4 Cases of open flap debridement

2nd Semester

4 Cases of guided tissue regeneration divided as follows;

- 2 Cases managed using bone graft only
- 2 Cases managed using bone graft + barrier membrane

4 Cases of furcation involvement divided as follows;

- 2 Cases managed by regenerative treatment
(1 case using a barrier membrane and bone graft
and 1 case with bone graft only)
- 2 Cases managed by resective treatment

3rd Semester

6 Cases of implant and peri-implant management

- 2 Cases conventional implant in the posterior zone
- 1 Case conventional implant in the anterior zone
- 2 Cases implant simultaneous approach with grafting
- 1 Case guided bone regeneration (GBR)

4th Semester

6 Cases of soft tissue management using different modalities;

- 2 Cases of augmentation of narrow zone of attached
keratinized gingiva using free gingival graft
- 2 Cases of recession coverage using modified coronary
advanced tunneling technique
- 1 Case recession coverage using coronally advanced flap
- 1 Case soft tissue management around dental implants

Essex Program (MSc Periodontology Science and Practice)



Students must successfully pass 120 credits of study at Essex including a thesis in 12 months period.
